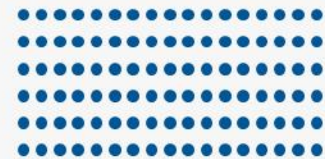

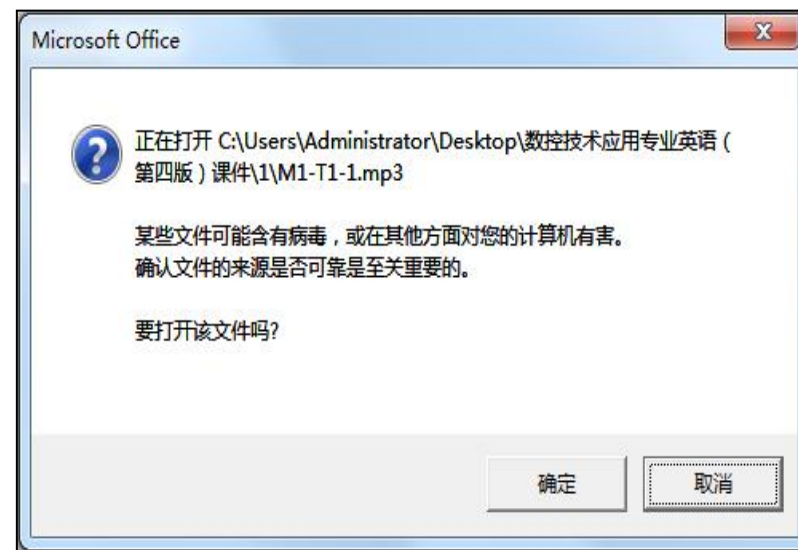

Communication Paves Your Way

- 1 Good communication is the most **practical** skill in job hunting. It's not just about what you know and who you know; it's also about whether you could **grasp** opportunities. Communication helps you get your foot in the door, but it will only get you so far. In the end, it's all about your **competence** to get the job offer.
- 2 **Get started** with group projects. **Keep in touch with** your group members and always exchange ideas. It is important to know great ideas are always **generated** through communication. It's **kind of** like building a savings **account**. You don't really need it right now. But on the day, when you need it, the ideas may come to you.

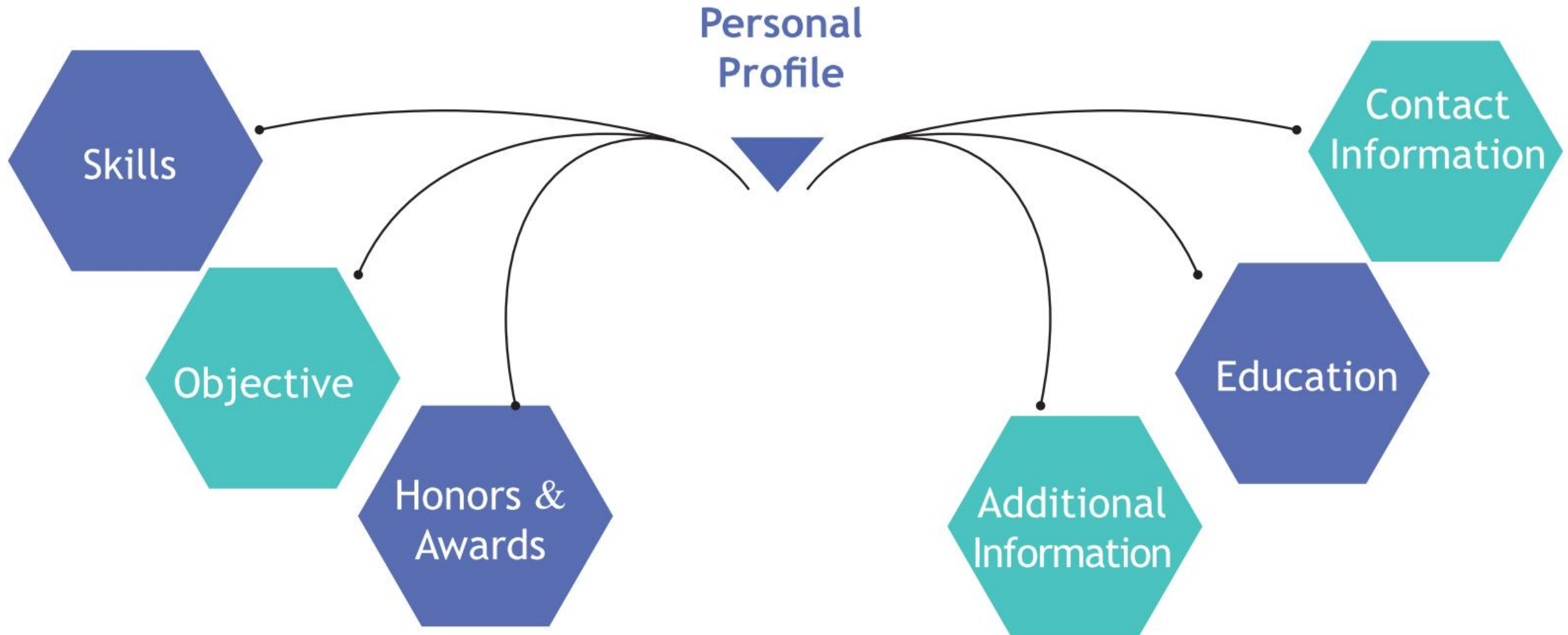

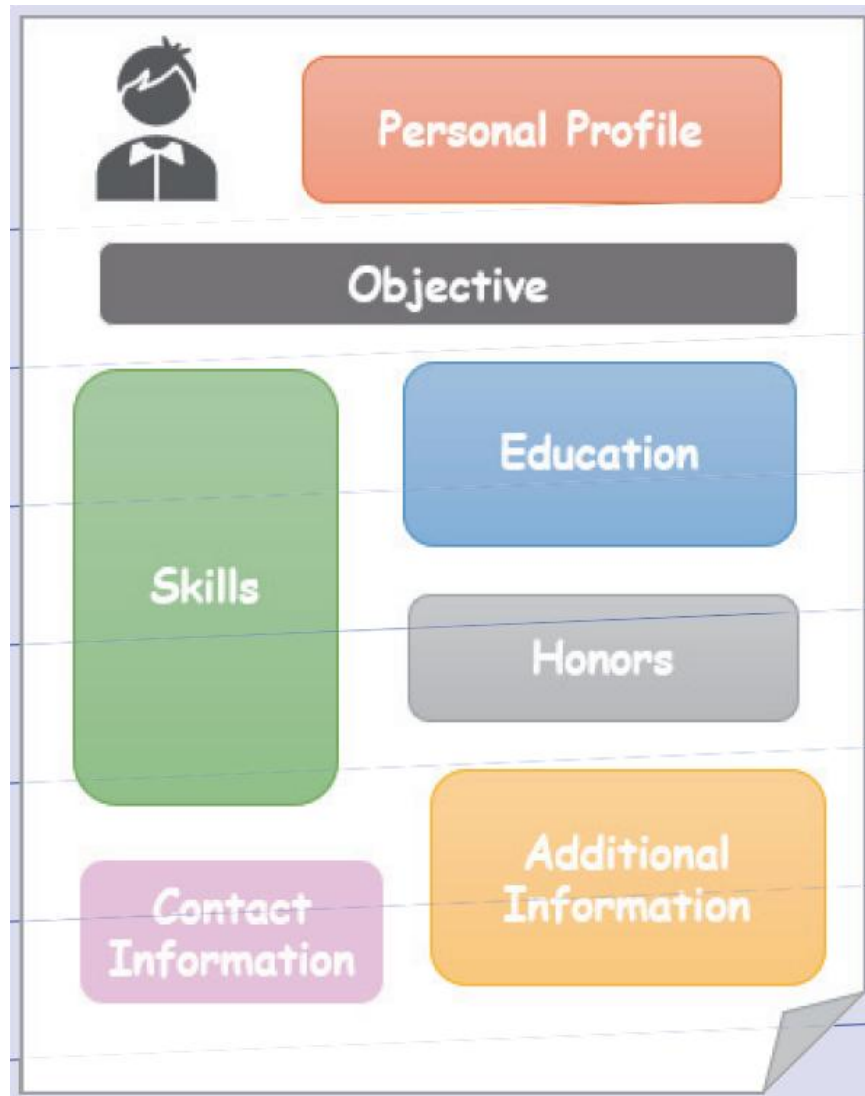

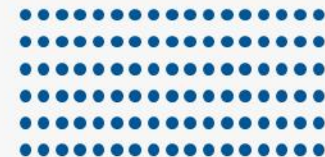
