




Therefore, digital information security is a paramount concern and we need to have a clear understanding of what is digital security and the tools to protect our network.

ATwitter has already seen a drop in users since American billionaire Ele Musk bought the online micro-blogging service last month.

Some users and experts have expressed concerns about Musk's plans to loosen the restrictions on users' content. Musk has said his goal is to protect the free speech of Twitter users. But critics say his plan could increase the amount of harmful content on the platform.

Bot Sentinel is a free platform that looks for untrustworthy Twitter accounts. It recently estimated that 877,000 Twitter accounts were deactivated between October 27 and November 1. Even if Twitter did lose nearly a million users after Musk's takeover, the social media service still remains huge. The company said earlier this year it had more than 238 million active daily users.

What are alternatives to Twitter? One of the main alternatives is a mi

blogging platform called Mastodon. Mastodon looks like and operates very similarly to Twitter. It lets users post short messages and other content. The service does not have advertisements.

Another alternative is a new social media platform called Cohost, which promises its users their personal data will never be sold.

Other established social networks like Tumblr and the voice-based app Clubhouse have also seen recent rises in popularity.

A few other startups are also gaining attention, including Counter Social and Tribel Social.







Email takes up to 28% average professionals' time and there are a set of rules and tips to follow in business emails. Proper email etiquette will not only allow you to maintain professionalism, but can also make your communication more effective and help the business avoid costly mistakes. Read the following email etiquette rules and tips and learn how to write an email professionally.

**Email Etiquette Rules and Tips** 











■ 1. Write a clear subject line.

As many of us are constantly buried in our inboxes, the subject line can have a significant impact on whether your email gets opened or not.

Aim for a clear and short subject line that describes what your email is about in a couple of words or a concise sentence. Use identifiers such as "proposal" and "application" that immediately tell the recipient explicitly what to expect from your email.











■ 2. Start with a professional greeting.

The best way to greet a person in an email always depends on your relationship with him/her and the subject matter. The appropriate way to start an email professionally varies from formal to casual, but you should never come across informal.

Some of the most common greetings include:

- Dear Ms./Mrs./Mr. <Last name>,
- Hello <First name>,
- Hi <First name>,













You shouldn't ever assume that the recipient knows who you are. Especially if you contact someone you don't know for the first time, it's part of email etiquette to start your email's body with a brief introduction — a short line or two covering relevant information will do. If you know the recipient but you're not quite sure whether your name rings a bell to him/her, find a way to mention the last time you talked or remind him/her how you know each other.













Be upfront about your email's purpose by stating it at the very beginning. Make your point fast, don't be wordy, and use short sentences that read well. Ideally, your email only has one goal, but if you need to cover different topics, consider condensing them to bullet points.

6. Structure the email properly.

A professional email should include a subject line, greeting, body, sign-off, and signature. Stepping away from this structure can be considered as a violation of email etiquette. You should always separate these parts with paragraph breaks to make your message easily readable.











■ 7. Watch your tone.

Be intentional with your word choices and always consider how the recipient might interpret them. As you can't rely on facial expressions and intonation to deliver the message, make an extra effort to come across as positive.

■ 8. Use a professional sign-off.

The best way to sign off an email always depends on your relationship with the recipient and your email's purpose. You should match the sign-off with the greeting and the rest of your message to maintain a consistent tone.



Social media has brought convenience for people to communicate and get information, but the perils and risks always exist. Be aware that social media is not a representation of reality. It is necessary to build healthy boundaries on social media and engage with the real world more.

## Passage 2



#### E-commerce Fuels Huzhou Writing Brush Sales

- 1. Huzhou writing brush makers have <u>achieved</u> anti-recession growth in sales by using e-commerce platforms.
- 2. Located in Huzhou's Nanxun district, Shanlian town is home to about 400 enterprises that make the writing brush, and more than half of them have opened online stores or <u>launched live streaming</u> channels to cope with shrinking offline sales. Their efforts to <u>tap into</u> online platforms have proved to be effective.











- 3. The output value of Shanlian's writing brush industry totaled 950 million yuan (\$135.7 million) in 2021, up 11.8 percent year-on-year. Of the 400 companies, over 200 achieved annual online sales of over 500 million yuan, official statistics show. According to Yao Yulin, a veteran Huzhou writing brush maker, she can sell more than 20,000 yuan worth of writing brushes in a three-hour live streaming promotion.
- 4. The local government has also been supporting brush makers by offering free live streaming venues and training sessions. Earlier this year, a professional live streaming center was launched in Nanxun district. In the first 11 months of this year, more than 300 live streams were staged in the center, resulting in 5.5 million yuan in sales, according to Zhong Guolin, vice general manager of the center.





- 5. Shen Minyong, Party secretary of Shanlian town, said that the facility's establishment will help extend the writing brush industrial chain, and can also act as a display platform to attract potential clients.
- 6. The Huzhou writing brush is a traditional Chinese brush pen that is believed to have a history of over 2,000 years. The brush, Hui ink, Xuan paper, and Duan ink slab are considered the "four treasures" of Chinese stationery. The craft of making the Huzhou writing brush was listed as a national intangible cultural heritage in 2006. The writing brush is an important contributor to the local economy.





#### Chinese Poetry

Poetry holds a uniquely significant place in Chinese culture, where it has been celebrated for millennia as one of the highest forms of artistic expression.

Chinese classical poetry is generally said to have reached the height of its perfection in the Tang Dynasty (618—907). This period held two of the most revered poets of all Chinese history—Li Bai and Du Fu. The shi style was perfected in this time, and other styles emerged as well. Perhaps the most notable was the ci style, developed at the very end of the Tang Dynasty.

Shi style is a broad term for Chinese classical poetry. Shi poems are composed of couplets. They are poems of two more coupled lines. The two lines of a couplet, generally with 4-7 syllables per line, usually rhyme and match rhythmically and complement each other tonally.











Ci poetry can be described as poems that have patterns of syllables and tonal patterns. In making a ci poem, a poet chooses words that fit a specific pattern. These patterns may have once been part of a song. But the music has been lost. There are various patterns that provided affective settings for various effects or moods.

**Exemplary Poets** 

Li Bai (701—762)

Li Bai was one of the great poets of the Tang Dynasty. He traveled widely and lived in both Chang An far to the north and Sichuan in the southwest. He wrote about places he visited and things he saw. His poetry is known for its clear imagery and conversational tone. He is described as a romantic poet.











Du Fu (712—770)

Du Fu liked to write in a structured form of poetry that was called Lu Shi, or regulated poetry. He is thought of as one of the greatest realist poets of China. His poems reflect the hard realities of war, people dying next to rich rulers, and primitive rural life. It is thought that he lived in a simple hut near the end of his life where he wrote many of his best realist poems. Perhaps more than 1,400 of his poems survived, and his poetry is still read and appreciated by modern Chinese people.














