



Startups

- Do you have an idea that you think could change the world? Are you dreaming about earning a big fortune by launching a business around this idea? You could be the founder of a startup.
- A startup is a young company in its early stages of development. In most cases, startups offer an innovative product or service that is either not currently available in the market or is being offered in a different way. They are the demonstration of creative and ambitious entrepreneurs who have amazing ideas. Another important feature of a startup is its ability to grow and make an impact.

7.1% of the startups in the world operate in the FinTech industry, followed by life science and healthcare with 6.8%, artificial intelligence with 5.0%, and gaming industry with 4.7%. Even though there isn't completely accurate data about industry distribution, it's clear that modern startups move towards the Internet and digital technologies.

Unicorn companies are startups that are valued at \$1 billion or more. There are currently more than 600 unicorn companies around the world. The majority of them are leading technology companies, in the fields of software, ecommerce, etc.

This initiative and the national strategy of innovation-driven development highlight China's strategic goal to develop an economy driven by innovation. They are of great significance to China's entrepreneurial environment.



Ren Zhengfei, an Entrepreneur with a Vision

- Founded in 1987, Huawei Technologies is a leading global provider of information and communications technology infrastructure and smart devices. Its founder and CEO, Ren Zhengfei, is one of the most famous entrepreneurs in China.
- Ren Zhengfei was born in 1944 in a remote mountainous town in Guizhou Province. He went to college in 1963, and after graduation, he had taken various jobs as technician and engineer.

In 1987, he founded Huawei in a modest apartment in Shenzhen, with a registered capital of 21,000 yuan. He had the great insight that China was ready for a big leap in personal communications. In 1990, Huawei started its own research and development from scratch, and three years later, became a telecom equipment vendor.

At the core of his leadership is the focus on the purpose of Huawei, which is helping customers to realize their dreams. Fueled by his passion, he works hard to translate this purpose into a vision — achieving a world leading status. He is continuously focused on the future and thinking about the company's development for the next decade.

What does a business plan include?

创业计划书(Business Plan)是一份创业者对于创业内容的详细计划书。创业计划书通常包括以下几个方面:

- 项目概况 (Executive Summary): 公司名称、宗旨、产品、预估员工人数、企业组织、管理制度、地点等。
 - ■主营业务 (Main Business):产品和服务、特点及优势、消费者受益处、定价等。
- ■市场分析 (Market Analysis): 市场现状分析、市场调研、目标市场、竞争对手情况等。
 - ■经营策略 (Marketing Strategy): 广告及推广活动策略等。
- ■资金规划 (Financial Planning): 初期投入预算、资金来源,应包括个人与他人出资金额比例、银行贷款等。
 - ■可能风险评估 (Possible Risk Assessment): 风险预期、拟解决途径。

创业计划书除了能让创业者清楚明白自己的创业内容,坚定创业的目标外,还具有说服他人的功用,例如,创业者可以凭创业计划书去说服他人合资、入股,募集创业基金。

Step 1

Think about the details of your startup business and draft an overview of your business, which will be the executive summary of your business plan. The overview should include the following points:

- The business you want to start;
- A description of your product or service;
- An overview of your target market;
- A brief description of your team;
- Location of your business;

Step 2

Create an outline of your business plan and get enough information for the key elements. Your outline might include the following sections:

- Executive summary;
- Products and services;
- Market analysis;
- Marketing strategy;
- Financial planning;

Step 3

Draft your business plan. Remember to just write down the essentials that your readers need to know and keep it short and simple. The following expressions might be useful:

We need a questionnaire to do the market research!

In this unit, we have practiced conversations about starting a business, and learned how to write a business plan. Now, let's practice having a discussion about how to create a questionnaire for the market research.

Scenario

You and your partner are going to open a milk tea shop on campus. Your business plan is partially done and what you need now is to conduct a market research to learn about the potential customers' preferences. Thus, you need to design a questionnaire to collect information from potential customers.





Step

Determining the Purpose of the Survey

Discuss with your partner what you want to learn from your questionnaire. Ask each other what data you require and how you will use it. This will help you come up with useful questions, as well as the order in which you will ask them.





Step

Making an Outline

Take down notes while having the discussion. Plan questions that will help you get the information you need.

Tips

- Begin with a broad span of questions.
- Then narrow them down until each one relates to your goals in some way.
- Keep questions and answers simple, using as few words as possible.





Step

Designing the Questions

After you have a general outline of the questionnaire, you can discuss how to use closed-ended and open-ended questions.

Tips

- Closed-ended questions have a specific range of options respondents can choose from. These questions may be yes-or-no questions, true-or-false questions, or questions that ask the respondents to agree or disagree with a statement.
- Open-ended questions solicit answers that you may not anticipate, and do not have a specific range of answers to choose from. Open-ended questions are a chance for respondents to communicate their specific experience or expectations.






Step

Piloting the Survey and Refining the Questions

Create the questionnaire and ask your classmates to test it. Ask your testers for feedback. They may alert you to sections that confused them or felt out of place.
